Dear Friends,


In a pre-Christmas speech in 1981, Shri Babaji said the following. "Everyone should forget nationality; we are all one here. This is a universal family." How those words rang in my heart this last month. Although I often feel like family with the many people who came to the Ashram, it was particularly pronounced while Bhaskaranand and Maheshanand where here. Right from the beginning of the two-week visit of our Dutch friends from Sada Shiva Dham Ashram it was apparent that we all came from the same stock. As we sang together, did fire ceremonies and pujas together, worked together, and discussed together: there was just so much harmony, joy, and ease. It is a wonderful thing about our Babaji family that we can travel throughout the world and sing the same aarati, perform the same pujas and fire ceremonies, and share karma yoga.

And then this feeling of oneness expanded as we traveled to the other spiritual centers in Crestone. The love and warmth with which we were received was deeply moving and sharing in some of their prayers made us feel at home. When we traveled to the Hanuman Temple in Taos, New Mexico we were joyfully greeted and invited to lead some Hanuman Chalisas in their temple before lunch. One of the members there accompanied my harmonium playing with drumming and about a dozen of us sang our hearts out with love for Hanuman. Sharing the delicious lunch they had prepared for us and stories about our three Ashrams made the afternoon fly by in delight.

We then headed for Santa Fe where a group of about a dozen devotees gathered on a day or two

notice to sing aarati, chant, and share Baba stories. Oh, it felt like the roof might lift off with all the shakti. Even the Catholic cathedral in Santa Fe was practicing my favorite Chritsmas Carol, "Oh Holy Night", which we sat and listened to. When we came to the Sikh Gurdwara in Espanola, it was locked, but a kind man appeared who knew about the Crestone Ashram, and he let us in.

And so it went on and on until the capper was when Aditya Kapoor, a long-time Baba devotee from India arrived with his son Vishwapratap. Sharing stories of his experiences in Haidakhan made us all feel Babaji's presence so deeply. The amount of times that he compared this Ashram here in Crestone to Haidakhan and the way certain things happened that reminded him of how Babaji would



orchestrate things was thought provoking and astounding.

We are all one universal family and it is spreading everywhere. As Babaji went on to say: "Have no idea of separation of identity; discard feelings of separateness. Serve the people with mind, body, wealth, and brain." May this year be full of universal love for all of humanity.

Ceremonies and Schedule

The full-moon fire ceremony this month is on Wednesday, January 15 and the new-moon fire ceremony is on Thursday, January 30. They will both be at 11am to reflect the later aarati time during the month of January. (They will move back to 10:08am in February.) The fire ceremonies are followed by a meal. Please arrive freshly bathed, in a long skirt or pants with shoulders covered, and having fasted from grains, cereals, meat, eggs, garlic and onions. Fruit, yogurt, nuts, veggies and tea or coffee are fine to eat before. Also, if you have a dietary need for something more hearty before our meal at 11:30 or so, please partake.

Our evening aarati is at 6pm and morning aarati will be at 8am during the month of January due to the cold and dark, with a paduka puja in Shri Babaji's kutir at 7:30am. Lunch is served at about 1pm, and we invite you to join us. (Call if you are a group or have special dietary needs.) The Maha Lakshmi Shop is open every day from 10am until 5pm.

What a wonderful two weeks it was hosting our Dutch friends, Bhaskarananda and Maheshanand, at the Ashram. Being a relatively quiet time at the Ashram, we had so many opportunities to share ideas, impressions, experiences and fun together. Taking them to many of the spiritual centers in Crestone while we were delivering our Christmas bread was a treat. We even took them to New Mexico to visit the Hanuman Temple, the Sikh Gurdwara, and St. Frances Cathedral. We also joined with our Santa Fe devotees for a beautiful evening of aarati, chanting, and satsang.

It was so inspiring to hear the tale of their Sada Shiva Dham Ashram in Holland and for them to hear our story. Although different of course, many themes were the same. Many hearts joined together in faith and love of Babaji creating the near impossible. I believe a deep and rich understanding and appreciation of one another came from this special time together. Here are some of their impressions.

"Thanks for the beautiful time we enjoyed at your Ashram. It has been an overwhelming experience to be here for almost two weeks. Our visit, of Maheshanand and me, was an outcome of the auction at Sada Shiva Dham in 2012, where the Crestone Ashram offered a two week stay at the Haidakhandi Universal Ashram. Luckily, I can say now, I 'won' this auction and as a result went in the third week of December, 2013 to Crestone.

From Denver airport, where Shashi Agarwal waited to receive us, everything went smoothly. We stayed overnight In Denver and the next early morning we went with Bipin Agarwal to the Ashram, a 4 hour drive. At arrival the full-moon havan was just about to begin, so we could sit right away at the havan, and a better spiritual welcome I could not have imagined.



At this time in December not many people stayed at the Ashram, only Ramloti, Prem, and Jonathan. It was a good occasion to come in this quiet time and to learn to know the Ashram and the people there.

The main murti in the temple is a big Mother murti representing Haidakhandeswari Ma, with all attributes from Laksmi, Durga, Saraswati, Mother Maria, and other devis. I could feel Her love and connection all around. Babaji was also very present and to enjoy the daily Paduka Puja at Babaji's feet was highly fulfilling. At night time the Paduka's stayed in the beautifully made Babaji kutir and during daytime they were in the temple, in the company of the Holy Mother.

other Babaji devotees to sing together Christmas carols in the temple. We even sang a few Dutch songs. Together with Ramloti, we visited many other spiritual centers in the area to bring Mother's Love and Christmas wishes, nicely expressed with the gift of special Christmas cakes made in the Ashram.
